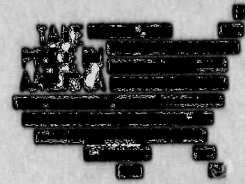

Gentlemen:

During an NRC inspection conducted on May 14 and 16, 1990;
one violation of NRC requirements was identified. The
violation involved the failure to perform physical
inventories at proper frequency (of every 6 months).

"Reply to Notice of Violation"

1) The reason for the violation was due to a
misunderstanding of the regulation. It was thought that if
the gages were not in use, the physical inventory was not
required.

2) Corrective steps are:

The RSD (presently Gerald Evans) will conduct a
physical inventory before each 6 month period and place
a written record of the inventory in the license file.

3) Corrective steps taken are:

A. A physical inventory has been conducted (see
Enclosure A).

B. A copy of this letter is attached to the front of
the nuclear license file marked "RSD - read
previous NRC violation—response and comply with
corrective actions".

4) A physical inventory was conducted on May 21, 1990 and recorded in the Nuclear License File kept at the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Phoenix Area Office.
