1. Question: What is the minimum aisle width between shelves?

Answer: 3 feet, 8 inches (44 inches) is required in specified locations on the drawings which constitute the means of egress from the area. Typically, these aisles are marked on the drawings as 3' 8" and run along the window walls, at each end of the enclosed areas, and at points where the aisles lead to exit doors from the enclosed file areas. However, the aisles which are not part of an egress route are specified at 36" apart.

2. Question Re the 5th Floor Shelving: Should shelving be 90" high or 84" high? Does shelving height include canopy top? Concern - sprinkler head minimum clearance allowed by fire code.

Answer: Shelving should be 90" where specified. Shelving height should include canopy top. Sprinklers in File Center have been engineered to specific locations over aisles and greater densities than would be required in office space where 18" is the maximum height allowed for furniture in a sprinkled space. The engineered sprinkler system overrides the 18" restriction. Generally, the tops of the files will be 12" from the File Center ceiling.

3. Question: How much clearance is required between shelving units and visual strobe fire alarm?

Answer: It depends on the situation. There is no set distance. The building contractor has located visual (and audible) alarms typically along the interior (corridor side) wall. After the files are installed, the area will be inspected by local fire authorities. They will determine at that time whether alarms are properly placed and whether or not they have to be moved or supplemented.

4. Question: Completion date of 03/09/94 not realistic.

Answer: We have changed the completion date for installation of the metal shelving to 03/21/94. In addition, the Wood End Panels that attach to the metal shelving being installed in the IRM Library and the ASLBP Library must be delivered and installed simultaneously with the metal shelving.

"Designated country end product," as used in this clause, means an article that (1) is wholly the growth, product, or manufacture of the designated country (as defined in section 25.401 of the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR)), or (2) in the case of an article which consists in whole or in part of materials from another country or instrumentality, has been
