Dear Mr. Haynes:

This transmission confirms the telephone report of September 21, 1982, by Mr. F.T. Eisenhuth to Mr. B. Bores of your staff. The event which required the prompt reporting is hereby summarized. The turbine building vent monitoring system noble gas monitor was declared out of service on 9/18/82 at 0730, and grab sampling once per 8 hours was initiated. However, the mechanical vacuum pump was in service until 1835 on 9/20/82, contrary to the provisions of Technical Specification Table 3.3.7.11-1, Item 3.a, Action 114. The condition is considered reportable in accordance with Technical Specification 6.9.1.8.a.
