

EDGEMONT DECOMMISSIONING PROJECT - SOURCE MATERIAL LICENSE SUA-816 - FINAL REPORT AND LONG-TERM SURVEILLANCE PLAN

TVA hereby request termination of its existing Jource Material License, SUA-816, and issuance of a possession-only license for the disposal basin. All work has been compreted for the Edgemont Decommissioning Project except for verification and documentation that vegetation cover and density have been established. This activity is planned for the summer of 1990 and will be provided to NRC when available.

In accordance with condition No. 22 of SUA-816, submitted separately are four copies of the TVA Edgemont Mill Decommissioning Project Final Report with seven attachments (maps, drawings, and aerial photos); and four copies of a TVA Edgemont Mill Decommissioning Project Long-Term Surveillance Plan with five attachments (maps, drawings, and aerial photos). TVA will retain ownership of the disposal site and the Long-Term Surveillance Plan provides information relevant to the location, description, surveillance, maintenance, and remedial response necessary to ensure long-term containment of tailings and contaminated material within the disposal basin.
