Thank you for your letter of September 2, 1982, informing us of steps you have taken to correct the violation concerning activities under NRC Construction Permit Nos. CPPR-158 and CPPR-159 brought to your attention in our letter of August 4, 1982. We have examined your corrective actions and plans and have observed in your response under "Corrective Steps Taken and Result. Achieved" that you stated: "As a result of our reinspection and review of DD?'s, further sampling and reinspection will be performed until we are confident that the deficiencies identified on the inspector in question are errors and not a result of incompetency or failure to inspect. To date, with the information that has been obtained, we do not think we can make a determination. This is the reason for increasing the sampling size."

This response is insufficient to permit determination if corrective action is adequate.

Pursuart to a telephone conversation on September 15, 1982 between Mr. M. R. Parsons, Project General Manager, and Mr. A. K. Hardin of this office, we understand that you will supplement your response by November 5, 1982, following further sampling and inspection.
