

Applicability of Funding Requirements

Byproduct Material Licenses 12-00722-04, 12-00722-06, and 12-00722-09 are for tritium sealed sources used in devices. The licenses cover a total of 1,047,500 curies tritium. Code of Federal Regulations, Title 10, part 30.35, requires decommissioning financial certification when the license possession limits exceed 10,000,000 curies. The licenses are below the possession limit requiring decommissioning financial certifications.

Byproduct Material License 12-00722-07 covers promethium 147 used in sealed sources. The license currently allows possession of any quantity. However, a license amendment application has been forwarded to require a possession limit below that for which decommissioning financial certification is required.

Byproduct Material License 12-00722-13 covers americium 241 used in plated foils for a total of 21 curies. Code of Federal Regulations, Title 10, part 30.35, requires statement of intent if the possession limit exceeds 100 curies. This license is below the possession limit for which decommissioning financial certification is required.

Byproduct Material License 12-00722-14 covers nickel 63 sources used as plated foils for a total of 800 curies. Code of Federal Regulations, Title 10, part 30.35, requires decommissioning financial certifications when the possession limit exceeds 100,000 curies. This license is below the possession limit for which decommissioning financial certification is required.

SUC 1380 covers 4,082,400 kilograms depleted uranium munitions (nondispersable form) and 239,500 kilograms depleted uranium contaminated firing ranges and equipment (dispersable form). The 239,500 kilograms depleted uranium in dispersable form is equal to about 120 curies or 120,000 millicuries depleted uranium. Code of Federal Regulations, Title 10, part 40.36, requires \$750,000 certification when the possession limit exceeds 100 millicuries depleted uranium in dispersable form. The amount required for certification is \$750,000.

SUB 1340 covers 10 kilograms of uranium 238 used in check sources in nondispersable form. Therefore, the decommissioning financial certification is not required for the license.
