Dear Administrative Judges:

This letter is written at the request of the Licensing Board Chairman, to memorialize the telephone conference call held on September 28, 1982. Participants in the conference call were Chairman Wolfe, Administrative Judge Jordan, Mr. Blake for the Applicant, Mr. Groesch for the Joint Intervenors, and Mr. Turk for the NRC Staff.

Chairman Wolfe related that Mr. Groesch had telephoned him to request that the conference call then scheduled to be held at Applicant's request (to set a hearing date) on September 29, 1982, be deferred until after the Joint Intervenors have filed certain pleadings now in preparation. Mr. Groesch identified those pleadings as (1) a motion for summary disposition on Applicant's emergency information brochure, (2) a request that Applicant be barred from submitting a revised brochure, and (3) a request to broaden the issues for hearing and to delay the issuance of any Partial Initial Decision. Mr. Groesch stated that these pleadings will be filed on September 29, 1982, and are approximately three pages in length.

It was agreed that the telephone conference call scheduled to be held on September 29, 1982, should be deferred until after the Joint Intervenors have filed their above-referenced pleadings and the other parties have had an opportunity to file written responses thereto. It was agreed that the Joint

Intervenors will serve their pleadings by mail on September 29, 1982, and simultaneously will provide a courtesy copy to Mr. Perry at Louisiana Power and Light Company in New Orleans; Mr. Perry, in turn, will transmit those pleadings by telecopy to Mr. Blake, who will hand deliver a copy thereof to Mr. Turk and three copies to Chairman Wolfe. Applicant and Staff will serve their responses by hand and/or express mail on or before October 4, 1982; the Licensing Board will then determine whether to proceed with a telephone conference call on October 7 or 8, 1982, and subsequently will issue a written order ruling on Joint Intervenors' motions.

Mr. Blake requested that the Licensing Board and parties continue to keep Applicant's proposed hearing date in mind, notwithstanding the deferral of the scheduled telephone conference call.
