We have concluded that your letter doesn't provide any new information nor change matters of fact with regard to our concerns about procedures for balancing system flows in the event of passive failures and the consequences of failures such as loop ruptures.

Accordingly, we still consider our July 20, 1982 Topic IX-3 safety evaluation report to be final and that evaluation will be a basic input to the integrated safety assessment for your facility. This topic assessment may be revised in the future if your facility design is changed or if NRC criteria relating to this topic are modified before the integrated assessment is completed.
