I. SECY-94-094 - Georgia Power Company -- Staff's Motion for Stay and Petition for Review of LBP-94-06

The Commission, by a 4-0* vote, approved an order responding to the NRC staff's motion for a stay and petition for review of LBP-94-06. The order directs the NRC staff, (1) to make available to the parties within seven (7) days for inspection and copying the documents and material identified in the list of exhibits to the OI report, and (2) at the time of issuance of an enforcement action (or upon a decision to take no enforcement action) the NRC staff shall make available to the parties for inspection and copying OI's report of investigation.

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* Section 201 of the Energy Reorganization Act, 42 U.S.C.
