We have not yet received the results. Please send us the results of your technical review or inform us when those results will be available.

The investigator who initiated that project has proposed a similar research initiative using free-living birds. Are you handling these reviews on a case-by-case basis? We would like to have reasonable assurance that the project could be approved, providing it is environmentally sound, before significant effort is put into compiling the proposal package.


