MEMORANDUM AND ORDER (Vacating OSC Protective Order; Denying Staff Motion for Protective Order)

Upon consideration of the parties' March 29, 1994 joint discovery status report, it is

ORDERED, that the portion of the Board's February 1, 1994 order granting the January 4, 1994 motion of licensee Oncology Services Corporation (OSC) for a protective order is vacated; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that the NRC staff's March 14, 1994 motion for protective order is <u>denied</u>, but without prejudice to any such future request by the staff; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that the staff shall notify the Board when it provides OSC with the nineteen documents that were the subject of the already-vacated portion of the Board's February 1, 1994 order granting the staff's January 14, 1994 motion for protective order. The staff shall provide this

In addition, the Board notes the following:

1. A filing requesting affirmative relief from the Board must bear a caption clearly indicating that it is (or contains) a motion. <u>See Duke Power Co</u>. (Cherokee Nuclear Station, Units 1, 2, and 3), ALAB-457, 7 NRC 70, 71 (1978). So too, a response to a pleading should be in a filing that bears a caption clearly indicating that it is (or contains) such a response.

2. A motion to compel a response to a discovery request must be filed within the time limits specified in 10 C.F.R. § 2.740(f), unless a party seeks and obtains an extension of time from the Board.

3. In response to a discovery request, claims of privilege (including claims relating to the fifth amendment privilege against self-incrimination) must be plead with specificity. <u>See Long Island Lighting Co.</u> (Shoreham Nuclear
