ORDER APPROVING AND INCORPORATING STIPULATION FOR SETTLEMENT OF PROCEEDING AND SETTLING AND TERMINATING THE PROCEEDING

Upon consideration of the Joint Motion for Order
Approving and Incorporating Stipulation for Settlement of
Proceeding and Settling and Terminating the Proceeding, and

Order Imposing Civil Monetary Penalty issued to AMS, and upon the consent of the parties, the Stipulation for Settlement of Proceeding is hereby approved and incorporated into this Order, pursuant to Section 81 and Subsections (b) and (o) of Section 161 of the Atomic Energy Act, as amended, 42 U.S.C. §§ 2111, 2201(b), and 2201(o) and is subject to the enforcement provisions of the Commission's regulations and Chapter 18 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, 42 U.S.C. § 2271, et seq. This proceeding is hereby terminated.
