Dear Mr. Schwencer:

In accordance with our response to the July 6, 1981 Acceptance Review Letter, Supplemental Request for Additional Information (SRAI) (9) we are providing the following information.

The preservice inspection plan for Limerick is divided into three parts. The first part includes all nondestructive examination items required to be inspected by ASME Section XI; with the exception of the reactor pressure vessel, its internals, and safe ends. The second part of the plan consists of the pump and valve tests as described in articles IWP and IWV of ASME Section XI. The third part includes the nondestructive examination of the reactor pressure vessel, its internals, and safeends.

With this letter we are transmitting five (5) copies of the first part of the plan for Unit No. 1. The second part of the plan will be transmitted by December 30, 1982 and the third part will be transmitted by June 30, 1983.
