## Gentlemen:

Thank you for your letter dated August 17, 1982, informing us of the steps you have taken to correct the items of noncompliance which we brought to your attention in Inspection Reports No. 50-456/82-01(DETP); 50-457/82-01(DETP) forwarded by our letter dated July 7, 1982. We will examine your actions relative to Violations 1, 3 and 4 during a subsequent inspection.

With regard to Violation 1, we must deny your request to withdraw the item. We fully understand your position regarding equivalent documentation relative to post-tensioning activities. Nontheless, S&L Specification L-2772 is specific in its requirements regarding the preparation, approval and use of stressing sequence drawings. Our follow-up inspection of this item will include verification of the proper stressing sequence, as required by the applicable work procedure and pertainent Field Change Requests. No additional response to this item is required.

In response to your comments regarding Violation 2, upon detailed review of the record we concur that the item does not constitute noncompliance with NRC requirements. We regret any inconvenience this may have caused you. Accordingly, Noncompliance No. 50-456/82-01-02; 50-457/82-01-02 will be deleted from our records.
