Inasmuch as your evaluation demonstrates that the calculated dose to the public would not exceed 1 rem effective dose equivalent or an intake of 2 milligrams of soluble uranium, your facility is not required to have an Emergency Plan. Accordingly, Safety Condition S-1 is amended to include the dates of November 9, 1993, and March 21, 1994.

All other conditions of this license shall remain the same.
