Per my conversation with your office on May 17, 1982 and your letter of May 20, 1982, please accept this letter as a request for the termination of our NRC License No. 12-00369-4E.

For a number of years our company manufactured and distributed nuclear analytical detection and measuring devices which used small sources for their calibration and maintenance. These sources contained exempt quantities and were distributed pursuant to the noted license.

Approximately three years ago ow: company sold that portion of our business dealing with all devices classified as our analytical line to Tracor Corporation. They are presently located in Elk Grove Village, Illinois - License Number 12-18379-03. This line of instrumentation included our liquid and solid state scintillation counting systems, etc.

To date, no material has been distributed under this license for the past two years, and is no longer required for its intended purpose.

All radioactive material that was in stock at the time of company purchase was either transferred to the Tracor Corporation location, stored for internal use or remanded

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to our hot drums for future burial purposes.
