In response to your question regarding the Advanced Medical Systems, Inc. (AMS), license during the August/September 1986 time frame, the following enclosed copies are forwarded for your information.

1. Amendment No. 3 dated June 25, 1986, terminates AMS' License No. 34-19089-02.
2. Amendment No. 8 of License No. 34-19089-01 dated June 25, 1986, effectively adds the licensing conditions of the former "02" service license to the "01" license, thereby assuring continued license coverage for AMS' activities. Amendment No. 8 has an expiration date of September 30, 1986.
3. Amendment No. 9, issued September 5, 1986, continues AMS' license through the September 30, 1986, termination date to October 31, 1986.
