Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. W. J. Slawinski of this office on September 15, 1982, of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material Licenses No. 34-00508-04 and No. 34-00508-06 and to the discussion of our findings with you at the conclusion of the inspection and to the telephone conversations with you and Mr. Ray DiRossi on September 21, 1982.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

In addition to the above areas, the inspector examined actions described in your letter dated November 6, 1979, regarding the leak testing and disposal of a carbon-14 sealed source which was possessed under License No. 34-00508-03. Also examined were your corrective actions regarding the apparent item of noncompliance found during our June 8, 1979 inspection of License No. 34-00508-04. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

No items of noncompliance with NRC requirements were identified during the course of this inspection of License No. 34-00508-06.

However, during the inspection of License No. 34-00508-04, certain of your activities appeared to be in noncompliance with NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Appendix. A written response is required.


