Dear Sir:

Florida Power Corporation (FPC) is submitting one original and ten copies of Revision 20 to the Crystal River Unit 3 (CR-3) Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR). Material contained in this revision reflects FPC's commitment in Reference 1 to adequately reflect in the FSAR those portions of the CR-3 Technical Specifications that were not transferred to the Improved Technical Specifications (ITS) implemented at CR-3 on March 12, 1994. For example, this revision contains the following:

- Section 1.7, Quality Program, reflects the textual changes necessary for the Quality Program to remain in agreement with ITS.
- Section 12.8, Administrative Control, reflects the Nuclear General Review Committee (NGRC) and Plant Review Committee (PRC) functions which are not described in the ITS.

This FSAR revision also includes material which describes modifications or changes to CR-3 that have been implemented since the last FSAR revision in July 1993. For example,

- Tables 8-1 and 8-2 reflect the latest emergency diesel generator loading profiles.
- Section 9.6.2.2 discusses the permanent canal seal plate installed in 1993.
- Sections 2, 4.3.11, and 11.5 address changes necessary to support implementation of the revised 10 CFR 20 requirements and programmatic updates of the radiation protection program.

The Quality Assurance Program description of the compliance with Regulatory Guide 1.54, Protective Coatings, has been revised (Table 1-3, page 1-136) to reflect the changes approved by the NRC in Reference 2.
