Dear Sir:

Pursuant to the provisions of 10CFR 2.201, MSN hereby submits a written statement of "Reply to a Notice of Violation".

Violation: Failure to adopt procedures to implement the substantive revisions to 10CFR21 that became effective on October 29, 1991.

- 1. Reason for violation: MSN's failure to update our Procedure SOP-601 afte: 10CFR21 had been revised.
- Corrective steps take. MSN has obtained the current copy of 10CFR21 and has written SOP-601 Revision 1, dated 3/3/94, that includes the requirements of the current revision of 10CFR21.
- 3. Corrective steps to avoid future violation: MSN has subscribed to NRC Information Notices and Bulletins which will keep MSN informed of future revisions of 10CFR21. MSN will review future revisions of 10CFR21 to verify MSN's procedural compliance.
- Date for full compliance: The MSN procedure has been rewritten and posted, effective 3/3/94. The subscription for NRC Information Notices and Bulletins was made on 3/24/94.
