On February 27, 2020, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") approved the transfer of control of NRC Material Licenses Nos. 13-35179-02 and 13-35179-03 ("the Licenses"), held by Global Isotopes, LLC (d/b/a Zevacor Molecular) ("the Licensee"). Approval of the indirect transfer of control was pursuant to a December 20, 2019 change of control application, submitted jointly by Curium US Holdings LLC ("Curium") and Illinois Health and Science ("IHS"), as supplemented on February 24, 2020.

This notice informs the NRC that on February 28, 2020, the transaction closed, effectuating the transfer of control over the Licenses. At this time, Curium seeks to amend the name on the Licenses to "Curium US PET LLC," and attached are two copies of NRC Form 313 providing the amended names (one for each License). In addition, enclosed is a signed copy of the relevant documentation indicating closing of the above-described transaction.
