SUBJECT: REVISION OF THE CURRENT SALP CYCLE

In order to provide an appropriate length of time to assess your overall performance in the safe operation of your facility since startup of one of the units, it has been decided to revise the SALP assessment period for the South Texas Project. As stated in the guidance for the new SALP process, specified in the NRC's Management Directive 8.6, the end date of the SALP period may be adjusted to include a period of 6 to 9 months after startup of the first unit from an extended outage.

Your current assessment period is being revised and includes the dates from August 2, 1992, to September 24, 1994. This revision supersedes the previous dates of August 2, 1992, to July 2, 1994.

Should you have any questions regarding the revised assessment period, I will be pleased to discuss them with you.
