



River Bend Station Unit 1 Locket No. 50-458 Final Report/DR-58

On June 3, 1982, Gulf States Utilities Company (GSU) notified the Region IV Office of a condition potentially reportable under 10CFR50.55(e) concerning indications found on shop radiographs of containment penetration bellows (DR-58).

GSU has completed its investigation and determined that no reportable deficiency exists. A review of field radiographs performed subsequent to the shop radiographs in question reveiled that no indications remained. This concludes GSU's response on this subject.
