
ORDER

By "Memorandum and Order" dated September 13, 1982, this Board ruled upon the standing, petitioners, admissibility of contentions, delineation of parties, and schedule for this Operating License proceeding. The "Memorandum and Order" was issued after the receipt of numerous pleadings, as well as two Special Prehearing Conferences held pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.751a. Subsequently, intervenor New England Coalition on Nuclear Pollution ("NECNP") filed objections to the Memorandum and Order together with a "Motion to Certify Objections to the Appeal Board." The State of New Hampshire filed its objections in the form of a motion for reconsideration.

Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.751a(d) as amended, no party may file replies to such objections unless the Board so directs. Accordingly, the Board directs that any party who wishes to file a reply to the above objections and request for certification should do so. Such replies should be in the hands of the Board by October 19, 1982, except that the NRC Staff may file any such response if it is in the hands of the Board by October 22, 1982. Written rejoinders to such responses will not be permitted without the prior authorization of the Board.
