Gentlemen:

Thank you for your letters of October 6, 1981, and January 28, 1982, in response to our letters dated September 18, 1981, and January 14, 1982. Our most recent letter dated May 6, 1982, requested deferral of any further response in regard to Items C and D of the Notice of Nonconformance until after a meeting with you concerning NRC inspection history and performance of a further planned inspection.

These activities were accomplished at your facility during August 23-27, 1982. As a result of NRC Regional management review of the two nonconformances in question during this last inspection, a determination has been made to closeout the stated nonconformances without requiring any further actions by you. This determination has been made based on our awareness that Bechtel is replacing the motors in question, and our evaluation indicating a contributory lack of specificity in the procurement requirements imposed on you by your customer. In the event of your future receipt of domestic nuclear contracts, our inspection planning will include a detailed assessment of relevant procurement control activities.

We have no additional questions in regard to this inspection and no further correspondence is required.
