SUMMARY

Scope:

This routine, unannounced inspection was conducted in the area of Physical Security for Power Reactors. The inspector specifically reviewed Testing, Maintenance and Compensatory Measures in addition to Training and Qualification. Additional effort was devoted to resolving NRC Allegation Number RII-90-A-0098. Safeguards Event Logs for the last three quarters were reviewed.

Results:

In the areas inspected, violations or deviations were not identified.

The licensee's program for testing and maintaining equipment appeared to be very successful; compensatory measures were minimal. Training and qualification of officers was professional. Allegation Number RII-90-A-0098 could not be substantiated. An Inspector Follow-up Item (No. 50-416/90-19-01) was opened relative to unsecured vital area doors being found by the licensee, corrected and documented in Safeguards Event Logs.

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
