Subject: Site Remediation Plan - McGean-Rohco Buildings


Dear Mr. Johnson:

As you know, Chemetron and McGean-Rohco are eager to begin the decontamination of the McGean-Rohco factory buildings. This is consistent with the NRC's objective with regard to cleanup of this site. Chemetron's plan for this decontamination has been presented in Appendix D of the "Site Remediation Plan - Harvard & Bert Avenue Sites," originally submitted in October, 1993." Chemetron has responded to the NRC questions and comments on the Plan, including those on Appendix D.

To enable Chemetron to start decontaminating the McGean-Rohco buildings as quickly as possible, it is requested that the NRC separately review and approve Appendix D and those aspects of Section 4 of the Plan that are necessary to begin the work. By separate correspondence, Chemetron will forward for your review the documents noted in Section 2.1.3 of the Plan. Chemetron will undertake the decontamination upon receipt of approval to begin the work.
