Dear Mr. Almas:

I am writing this letter in response to a recent telephone conversation you conducted with Richard Chancellor of the Land Quality Division. In that conversation I understand that you inquired as to the scheduling of Steve Ingle's review of the monitor well package submitted under cover of Mr. Terry Wetz's letter dated March 16, 1994.

As I explained to Mr. Wetz by telephone on March 24, Mr. Ingle had indicated to me that he felt he had to review both the March 16, 1994, monitor well package and the main March 3, 1994, response package together. Based on that consideration and his heavy workload, Mr. Ingle predicted he would complete review of the wellfield package by mid to late April.

However, due to the unexpected resignation of another groundwater hydrologist this week, Mr. Ingle stated today that his supervisors met and decided the earliest he could begin his review would be April 27, 1994.
