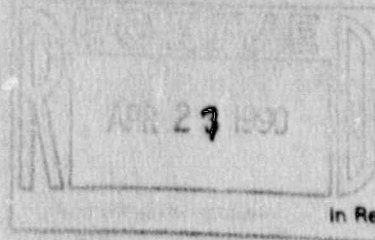



sioning, funds would be obtained when necessary."


