Dear Sir:

The radioactive waste management and storage area is located in the basement of the Service Center Building of the Health Sciences Center. Due to recent rains, water was noticed on the floor are ind the steel barrels containing radioactive material. Water has never been noticed prior to the rains during April 23 to 30, 1990. Due to the water, we would like to make modifications of the storage room.

During the renovation period the radioactive waste packed in 55 gallon barrels and in 4 cubic ft. cartons will be moved out of the storage rooms. The waste storage area will be surveyed, wipe tested and released for renovation.

Please permit the storage of packed waste in a suitable area detailed below:

- A suitable covered metal trailer will be rented and parked in the compound outside the storage area.
- The trailer will be locked and properly posted.
- Access to the trailer will be limited. It will be enclosed by a fence.
- Room 70, College of Health, which is under the full cor+rol of the Office of Radiation Safety.

The modifications of the existing waste storage room include the following:

- 1. Extending the interior balcony to provide more space for storage.
- To fix 2 x 4 treated wood on the floor to raise the 2. barrels to assure integrity of the containers.
- 3. Outside the waste area, we plan to add a covered section enclosed with fence. This area will be used to house fire proof steel cabinets for storeage of scintillator fluid containers. This area will also be used to store some radioactive waste containers.

Only persons authorized by the Office of Radiation Safety Office will be working in the radioactive waste storage areas. All areas will be locked when not attended by authorized persons.

Modified area drawings will be submitted for record.
