

Revised Description

The shipper is Atomic Energy of Canada, Limited. The consignee is the U.S. ERDA Savannah River Plant, E. I. DuPont de Nemours, Inc., Dunbarton, South Carolina. The point of entry into the USA shall be one of the following: Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan; Port Huron, Michigan; Alexandria Bay, New York; Champlain, New York; or Derby Lane, Vermont.

The shipments are scheduled to commence as soon as necessary (local) approvals are obtained and weather permits. A total of six successive shipments will follow, approximately one week apart. It is desirable to complete all six shipments prior to July 1, 1982. This license is requested for the period through November 1, 1982, or upon the completion of the shipment of 32 Kg SNM, whichever occurs first.

Starting date of proposed shipments: NAC proposes to start the first shipment about May 15, 1982.
