- SAN ONOPE UNIT 1, FOLLOW-UP SAFETY INJECTION SYSTEM FAILURES (PM)
 - SIS SYSTEM - 9/3/81 FAILURE
 - PLANT CORRECTIVE ACTION, ECCS MODIFICATIONS
 - TEST AND SURVEILLANCE PROGRAM
 - PRELIMINARY RESULTS OF TESTING

- PILGRIM 1, HEAT EXCHANGER FAILURE (IE)

 - NO OPERATIONAL PROBLEMS HAVE EVEN BEEN OBSERVED WITH THIS PHENOMENON
