Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine, unannounced radiation safety inspection conducted by Messrs. Anthony D. Gaines and Gilbert L. Guerra, Jr. of this office on October 10, 1990, of the activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 49-19237-01, and to the discussion of our findings held by the inspectors with members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under the license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of the license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews of personnel, independent measurements, and observations by the inspectors.

During this inspection, certain of your activities were found not to be conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements. Consequently, you are required to respond to this matter in writing, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Your response should be based on the specifics contained in the Notice of Violation enclosed with this letter.

In their review of your program, the inspectors noted administrative and staff interest in the program, which is essential in maintaining an effective nuclear medicine program. Although violations were observed by the inspectors, with prompt corrective action the program should continue at a level within the expectations of the NRC. The inspectors observed no major problems with the program and appreciated the helpfulness of the staff.

The inspectors also reviewed the actions you had taken with respect to the violation observed during our previous inspection conducted on April 27, 1988. They verified that the corrective actions for the violation had been implemented.
