Dear Mr. Rose:

This is to confirm our telephone conversation today in which I responded to your September 28, 1982 letter to me by stating that Interrogatories 77-1 and 77-2 on page 7 of the Staff's Amended First Set of Interrogatories to Intervenor Rockford League of Women Voters were inadvertently included as the result of a typographical error. As you pointed out, those two interrogatories relate to Contention 70, which has been stricken. The Staff withdraws the interrogatories numbered 77-1 and 77-2.

The Staff notes that under the Licensing Board's Memorandum and Order, dated August 30, 1982, discovery initiated on or before November 15, 1982 "will be concluded within thirty days of initiation." This language may be interpreted as extending the normal fourteen day response period for interrogatories to thirty days. Accordingly, we look forward to receiving the League's answers by October 15, 1982.
