SUBJECT: REQUALIFICATION PROGRAM INSPECTION - NINE MILE POINT STATION, UNIT 1

In order for the NRC to adequately prepare for this inspection, please furnish the following materials by May 6, 1994.

- The annual operating tests for the week of June 6 and the previous two weeks (May 23 and 30).
- Sample Plan for the five-week exam period.
- Training Department procedures for: examination preparation and administration; student feedback system; remedial training program; simulator training; and JPM training.

Mr. Hartranft has been advised of this request.

The request for requalification examination material is covered by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Clearance Number 3150-0101, which expires on October 31, 1995. The estimated average burden is 4.0 hours per response, including gathering, copying, and mailing the required material.
