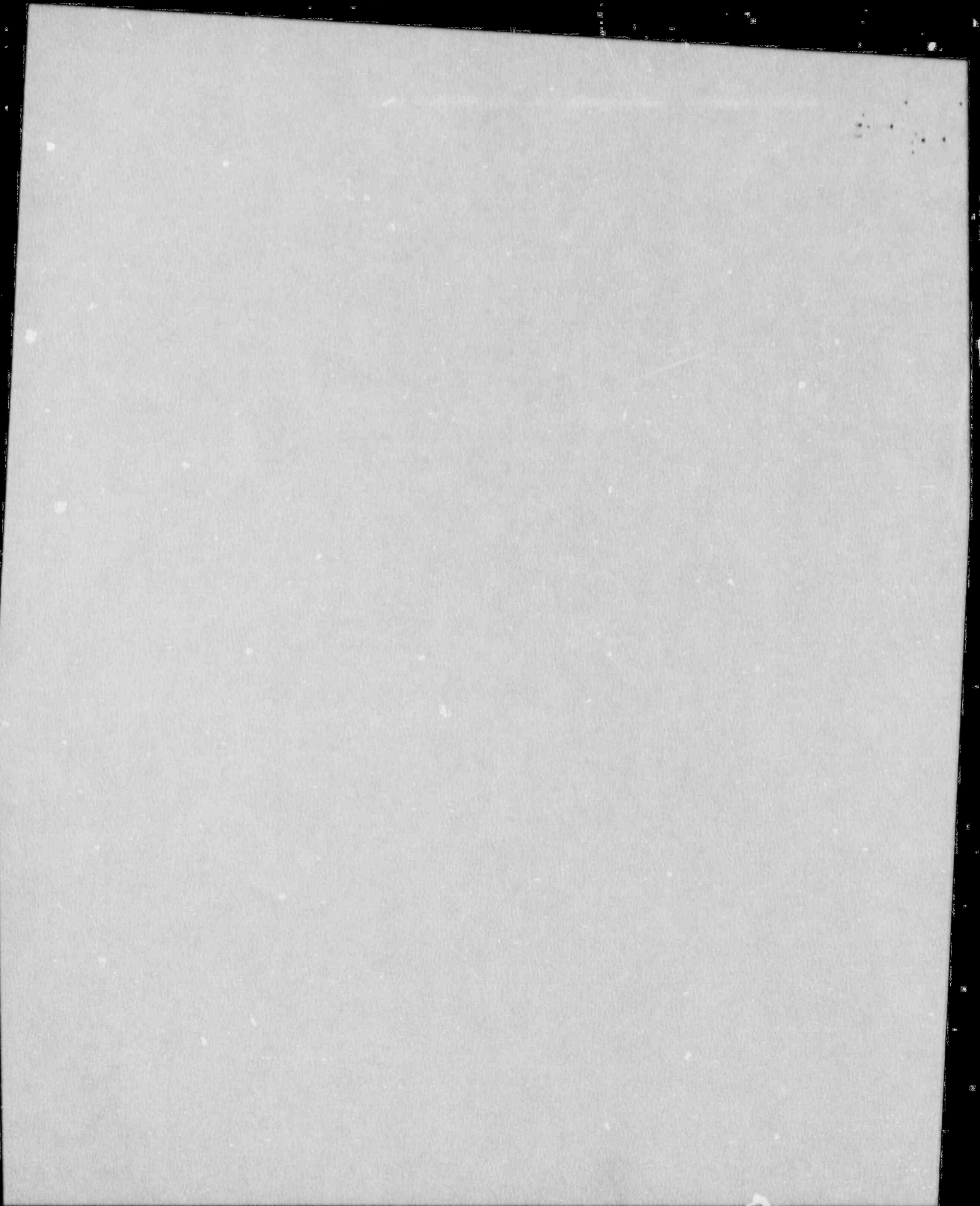

CHAPTER 1 - INTRODUCTION

1.1 INTRODUCTION

In accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 73.55, Appendix B, this Training and Qualification Plan outlines the process by which security force personnel assigned to Florida Power and Light Company's (FPL) Turkey Point Plant are selected, trained, tested and qualified. Upgraded training requirements submitted in Revision 07 of this document shall be fully implemented within twelve months of the date Revision 07 is approved by the Site Vice President - Turkey Point.

1.2 OBJECTIVE

The objective of this plan is to ensure that the security force is capable of performing assigned crucial tasks necessary to implement Turkey Point's Physical Security and Safeguards Contingency plans.

1.3 SCOPE

This plan applies to the crucial tasks identified and the security personnel whose positions appear in the Responsibility Matrix, Appendix A. This plan is not applicable to nor does it imply a training program for FPL and contractor management positions. *THESE POSITIONS ARE DEFINED AS THE MANAGEMENT POSITIONS NOT APPEARING IN APPENDIX A.*

responsible management personnel and by a professionally trained and licensed individual. If a verifying examination is performed which reveals no condition which would interfere with the performance of assigned duties, the individual shall be permitted to continue assigned duties.

2.4 PHYSICAL FITNESS QUALIFICATIONS

Subject to a prior physical examination conducted by a licensed physician and written certification that there are no medical reasons to preclude participation by the individual, armed personnel shall take a job related physical fitness test before being assigned armed duties.

2.4.1 Initial Qualification

On initial qualification, all members of the security force shall demonstrate performance of items 1 through 5 below within a one (1) hour time limit. ~~Should a designated activity be required to be performed on-site, time required to transport and process personnel into the Protected Area for those items which must be performed on site shall not be considered as part of the one (1) hour requirement however, such transport and processing shall be conducted as expeditiously as practicable.~~

1. Climb up and down 35 foot ladder.
2. Climb up and down 40 feet of stairway within three (3) minutes.
3. Run 440 yards in two (2) minutes.

CHAPTER 4 - FIREARMS

4.1 TRAINING

Security force personnel assigned in an armed capacity shall be trained and demonstrate proficiency in the use of firearms (shown by duty position in Appendix A of this document) by achieving a passing score prescribed in the Conditions and Standards for qualification involving live fire as defined in Appendix B of this document. Firearms qualification includes familiarization firing for night and stress conditions. *SECURITY OFFICERS WILL BE ARMED ONLY WITH THE TYPE OF WEAPON WITH WHICH THEY HAVE SUCCESSFULLY QUALIFIED.*

All firearms qualification courses described in Appendix B of this document have been registered with, and approved by, the National Rifle Association. Approval letters are maintained and available for inspection.

4.2 QUALIFICATION/REQUALIFICATION

Armed members of the security force will qualify with each firearm required by duty position prior to assignment to such armed duty and every twelve (12) months thereafter.

4.3 SECURITY FORCE EQUIPMENT

Members of the security force are provided equipment in accordance with the provisions of the approved Turkey Point Physical Security Plan.
