SUBJECT: EMERGENCY DIESEL GENERATOR SURVEILLANCE TESTS, SAFETY EVALUATION  
CLARIFICATION, SALEM NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION, UNITS 1 AND 2 (TAC  
NOS. M79960 AND M79961)

By letter dated November 30, 1993, Amendment Nos. 148 and 126 were issued to  
Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-70 and DPR-75, respectively. Subsequent  
to that issuance, your staff identified some inconsistencies in the safety  
evaluation that accompanied the amendments. The inconsistencies are as  
follows:

1. Page 3, Change 7, it should be clarified that there are two 30,000-gallon  
storage tanks per unit for a total of four tanks.
2. Page 8, Change 24, the quotation of the change is incorrect. After  
"i.e.," the words "other than" were left out.
3. Page 10, Change 33, the changes were characterized as editorial. However,  
by deleting an exception statement, a requirement to load the diesel  
generators while performing surveillance tests in Mode 5 and 6 was added.

Enclosed are replacement pages for the safety evaluation. The pages have been  
revised to incorporate the changes described above. These changes only affect  
the safety evaluation and not the technical specification pages that were
