SUBJECT: LOSS OF BRACHYTHERAPY SOURCES DURING TRANSIT

On Friday, November 2, 1990, Anaheim Memorial Hospital packaged 2-50mCi, 3-25mCi, and 2-12mCi (total 199mCi) Cs-137 sealed source brachytheraphy needles in an authorized DOT shipping container and shipped them to Therapeutic Nucleonics, the manufacturer, by Federal Express. The DOT container arrived at a manufacturer Monday, November 5, 1990, and was first opened November 6, 1990, Tuesday afternoon. The 7 sealed sources were not in the container and the manufacturer immediately called the Los Angeles County Health Department, who under contract to the State carries out the Agreement State responsibilities for California in Los Angeles County.

The County immediately traced the shipment to the Federal Express transfer location in Los Angeles and sent an inspector to investigate. Using a survey instrument, the inspector found 5 of the missing sources scattered on the floor under the conveyor and the remaining two on a shelf where the employees had stored them. The inspector then isolated the area and called the manufacturer who retrieved the sources. The intentially exposed personnel were sent for medical evaluation. DOT has been contacted with the State is conducting a complete investigation. The jurisdiction for this incident resides with the State and DOT.
