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

We now have a problem that we would like to solicit some support from your office.

Central Montana Medical Center has a nuclear medicine department which is regulated by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. Over the past three or four years particularly, we have had a very tough time dealing with the Commission over our annual fees. The regulations allow for small entities (which ours certainly is) to apply for substantially reduced annual fees. We have been frustrated at every turn to get a ruling from the Commission as to our qualifying status. I have been personally involved for over 18 months regarding our 1992 fees. The folks at the Commission do not return calls, do not keep promises, do not answer correspondence (even requested information).
