Since our last meeting in Washington, D.C. on February 6, 1990 Omaha Public Power District (OPPD) has completed full implementation of a majority of the 72 major safety initiatives established under our Safety Enhancement Program (SEP). These initiatives, which affect virtually all areas of OPPD's nuclear organization, were designed to help us achieve substantial improvement in the safe operation of our Fort Calhoun Station. Recent assessments of our performance in both the SALP and INPO evaluations, and in our own internal evaluations, have indicated marked improvements as a result of the SEP.

We would like to invite you and members of your staff to visit Fort Calhoun Station and view the positive changes that have been made since the SEP's initial establishment in 1988. We are obviously anxious to share our successes with you. But, even more important, we'd welcome your observations.
