
Dear Mr. Axelrad:

I have now obtained from a newspaper reporter a copy of "Licensee's Submittal in accordance with Memorandum (Memorandum of Conference Call of October 19, 1990)," which was not available to me yesterday when I transmitted to Judge Bloch a letter responding to your letter to him of October 30. This Submittal was apparently omitted from the package mailed to me.

At page 3 you state that you disagree with the Intervenors' interpretation of the Seehars and Schwendiman articles, and state that the Intervenors should provide copies for the record. May I remind you that it was the Licensee that first cited and relied upon those articles, in its so-called "Summary of accident analysis." Despite all of our pleading with the University, and the filing of a Sunshine Act lawsuit approximately four months ago, we were never able to obtain copies from the University.

Since the Licensee cited and relied upon those documents, and the Intervenors are challenging the Licensee's reliance upon them, and the Licensee has the burden of proof, it is the Licensee who should provide them. If the Licensee does not have them, however, let me know and I will see to it that copies are made available to the Licensee and the Judge. If the Licensee needs them urgently, let me know.
