
Dear Judge Bloch:

I have Mr. Axelrad's letter of October 25. With one exception, I have no difficulty with his suggestion.

As Mr. Axelrad says, my notes show that Mr. Axelrad stated that, upon receiving the staff's affidavit, the Licensee informed the Staff that the amendment authorizing 25 curies of americium exceeded the amount of americium referenced in § 30.32 (i). However, my notes do not indicate that Mr. Axelrad also stated that the Licensee "had mentioned . . . the applicability of the MURR Emergency Plan to the TRUMP-S work to Region III personnel." On the contrary, my notes show that Mr. Axelrad stated that he was not sure about the balance of the conversation, that the Licensee either indicated that it had an emergency plan or that an analysis would satisfy the alternative requirement of § 30.32(i).

Because this was only a conversation, not a pleading or an order, I am not sure that it makes a lot of difference, but I submit this response in the interest of accuracy.
