Nevertheless, it is important to stress that subsequent to your April 1990 inspection, which gave rise to your violation findings, we have devoted ourselves to correct the deficiencies which were clearly hindering our Radiation Safety Program. In that respect, our good will has been demonstrated beyond any reasonable doubt.
