Subject: BOMB THREAT
At 1:08 a.m., October 1, 1982, an outside line phone call (anonymous; seemingly male, angry, vulgar, and inebriated) expressed discontent with increasing electric rates and stated "the place will go tonight." The licensee notified the Lecal Law Enforcement Agency and began a search of the protected area perimeter and all vital areas. Then, about $1: j 8$ a.m., a call was received from inside the plant (from a seemingly sober person) stating that "you have a bomb up your a--!". After the search found nothing unusual, the licensee secured from the event at 2:45 a.m.

About 1:38 a.m., the licensee notified the NRC Headquarters Duty Officer, who notified Region I about 1:40 a.m. Neither the licensee nor the NRC plan a press release, but will respond to inquiries. Media coverage has occurred. The IAT has been notified. The licensee notified the FBI and the New Jersey State Police.
