Dear Congressman Synar:

I am responding to your October 10, 1990, letter regarding Mr. Leif Robert G. Olson's allegation that the environment near his home, near Lake Tenkiller, was contaminated from chemical fallout from operations at Sequoyah Fuels Corporation (SFC).

Our regional office in Arlington, Texas, contacted Mr. Olson on October 30, 1990, to discuss his concern. During this conversation, Mr. Olson expressed great satisfaction with the responsiveness of SFC, especially Mr. Reau Graves. SFC has provided Mr. Olson with information about SFC operations and sample containers to obtain rainwater samples for analysis by SFC.

I have enclosed a copy of the initial letter from Region IV to Mr. Olson dated November 13, 1990. The Region IV office will review the actions of SFC regarding this matter during a future inspection. We will advise you of the final resolution of this matter.
