SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT 030-03738/94-01

This refers to the routine, unannounced inspection conducted by Ms. M. Linda McLean of this office, accompanied by Mr. Robert Sapp from Colorado Department of Health, on April 7, 1994. The inspection included a review of activities authorized by Byproduct Materials License 05-07872-01. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with members of your staff.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under the license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of the license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, and interviews of personnel.

No violations or deviations were identified; therefore, no response to this letter is required.

The inspector reviewed your implementation of revised 10 CFR Part 20 which went into effect January 1994. It was noted that you had changed many of your procedures to reflect the changes in the regulations. In particular, you developed and documented in your radiation safety program changes which demonstrated compliance with 10 CFR Part 20, such as the addition of an ALARA review in your quarterly radiographer audits, and by documenting the changes in your updated operating and emergency manual and radiographer exams.

The inspector noted that the overall radiation safety program seemed adequately managed. It was determined that you periodically performed licensed activities in Wyoming and Oklahoma, areas under NRC jurisdiction. This inspection did not include the observation of work practices at these temporary jobsites.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
