Background

A followup post fire safe shutdown capability inspection was conducted May 21-24, 1990, whereby contractor support was obtained from Brookhaven National Laboratory (BNL). In an area (safe shutdown procedures) which one of the contractors was reviewing, information was developed which warranted notification to the Office of Investigations (OI).

Objective

The objective of this Task Assignment is to first meet, discuss and review at the Region III office with the contractor involved, Mr. Keith Parkinson, the background information surrounding Abnormal Procedure DB-OP-02519, Serious Control Room Fire, and then to conduct an on-site OI investigation of this issue.

Work Requirements

The contractor shall furnish to the NRC staff, the individual involved in identifying the issue of concerns so as to perform the work outlined below.

1. Prepare for the meeting by reviewing the applicable documentation.	On day(s) of meeting
2. Travel to Region III and attend meeting at the Region III office.	Day(s) of meeting.
3. Depart Region III, travel to site to assist in investigation and prepare trip report.	Remainder of week

Level of Effort

The level of effort is estimated at 5 professional staff days, broken down as follows for planning purposes for the individual:

2.	1 to 2

This investigation is scheduled for January 28 thru February 1, 1991.

Technical Reporting Requirements

At the completion of Task 3, submit a technical letter report to the Region III Field Office (E. Pawlik), Enforcement Coordinator (Donald Funk) with a copy to the Project Manager.

Meetings and Travel

One one-person, five-day trip to the Region III office located in Glen Ellyn, Illinois and to the plant site in Oak Harbor, Ohio for investigation assistance.
