AMENDMENT TO TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION CHANGE/CLARIFICATION OF

NUMBER OF MEMBERS IN QUORUM AND STATEMENT IN INSERT A

On August 31, 1990, South Carolina Electric and Gas Company (SCE&G) submitted an amendment to a Technical Specification change dated July 18, 1990. The change was proposed to delete Plant Safety Review Committee (PSRC) chairman and member titles from Technical Specification 6.5, "Administrative Controls/Review and Audit." The amendment to the change was proposed to clarify that the majority of voting members in any PSRC meeting shall be appointed members and not alternates.

After a conversation on September 5, 1990, with Mr. J. J. Hayes, Jr., Project Manager with the NRC, an additional amendment to the Technical Specification change has been proposed. The proposed change is intended to clarify that the quorum shall consist of a chairman or his alternate and a majority of the PSRC appointed members or their alternates.

An additional conversation was held with Mr. Hayes on September 6, 1990, to propose an additional amendment. This change is proposed to clarify a statement in Insert A of the original Technical Specification change, and to reiterate that management staff at the plant include managers and above.

The change request is contained in Attachment 1 of this letter.

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The change to Technical Specification 6.5 has been reviewed and approved by the Plant Safety Review Committee and the Nuclear Safety Review Committee. Since the proposed amendment to this Technical Specification change is administrative and is intended to provide clarity, the supporting Safety Evaluation and No Significant Hazards Determinations for the change to Technical Specification 6.5, dated July 18, 1990, is applicable. Therefore, SCE&G requests Nuclear Regulatory Commission review and approval of this amendment by February 1, 1991.
