We wish to apply for an import license to cover the following material:

5,000,000 kilograms of uranium containing 250,000 kilograms of uranium-235.

The material is to be enriched to 5.0 w/o maximum, coming from various foreign facilities. After import the material will either go to Edlow International Company's storage facility in East St. Louis, Illinois, or to another intermediate consignee for conversion and/or fabrication. Ultimate end use for the material is in the civilian nuclear lightwater reactor program.

The material will be imported via ocean freight and trucked to inland destinations. Import will be in packaging with an approved US Department of Transportation IAEA Certificate of Competent Authority. The date of proposed first shipment is December 1982, with the last shipment proposed for December 1992.
