Thank you for your response of March 31, 1994, to our Notice of Violation, issued on February 14, 1994, concerning activities conducted under NRC License No. 45-23645-01NA at the Naval Air Weapons Station, China Lake, California (Navy Radioactive Materials Permit No. 04-60539-L1NP). We have examined your response and found that it meets the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201.

With regard to your response to Violation B, we are evaluating your response but note that you have taken corrective action to assure that any future releases from the holding pond are surveyed before discharge. We will inform you of the results of our final evaluation of your response to Violation B following receipt of your response to Violation C.

We will examine your corrective actions for Violation A during a future inspection. Your cooperation in this matter is appreciated.
